Below are the training requirements by OSHA;

- Students have a maximum of 180 days (6 months) to complete the training, so there are no scheduling issues or loss of production associated with traditional classroom training.
- A quiz is provided after completing each individual course. Minimum passing score of 70% is required and the student is allowed three attempts. After passing all assigned courses then the Student must take the Training Final Exam.
- Upon receiving a passing grade of 70% or more on the Final Exam and completing the OSHA Survey, OSHA cards are provided directly through OSHA within 6 to 8 weeks. (Printable temporary certificates of completion are available as well.)
